Art

Year group	Topics covered

Food

Year group	Topics covered
9	Students are building food knowledge on food commodities – cereals and meat. As well as macro nutrients, micronutrients and nutrition for different stages of life.
10	Exam Preparation for June exam (now not happening but students will still receive a grade and must complete the work) Factors effecting sucess, Operations of a Kitchen, Front of House operations. There are also some practical options to complete.
