#### **Statement of Purpose**

#### Main Duties/Responsibilities

**Sports Coaching Curriculum** 

- Deliver swimming lessons, particularly at Key Stage 1 and 2.
- Undertake coaching duties within a designated year group and curriculum area.
- Assist in whole school and year group lesson planning which meets the needs of all pupils at KS1-2.
- Monitor and assess pupils' results and progress, ensuring appropriate records are kept, and
  use the information to lesson plan and differentiate schemes of work.
- Contribute to development planning, evaluation and quality improvement processes.
- Provide extra-curricular opportunities at Boldon School and local primary schools.

#### **Physical Education**

- Work in partnership with School Sport Network to plan and implement appropriate sport competitions.
- Promote, develop and support the delivery of high quality PE coaching and learning within our partner primary schools.
- Assist staff to develop confidence and competence in PE.
- Play a fundamental role in providing a broad and engaging Primary PE curriculum.
- Review and update schemes of work in line with updates to the national curriculum.
- Support the delivery of school sports clubs aimed at the least active and most vulnerable children.
- Develop plans and opportunities for children to become more active and lead healthier lifestyles.
- Develop links with local schools to promote friendly contests.
- Develop talent pathways for exceptional children.
- Develop links to both local and national bodies such as the national governing bodies of sport (e.g. The Football Association (FA).
- Play a leading role in preparing children for competitions, transporting them to and from competitions and coaching them during competitions as part of the School S[port Network programme.

### **Record Keeping**

Develop effective systems for planning, assessment and record keeping in PE.

#### **Professional Development**

- Undertake appropriate and agreed continued professional development.
- Share expertise, in particular PE expertise, with other members of staff.

## **Health and Safety**
