Unifrog will help you to explore your key interests and what career paths you can take to reach your goals!

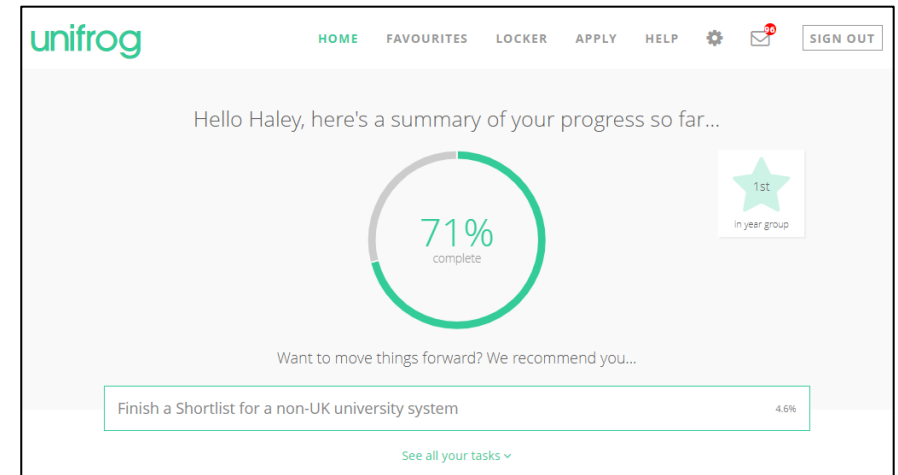

Holding Ctrl and clicking the image will take you to the Loom website to play the video.

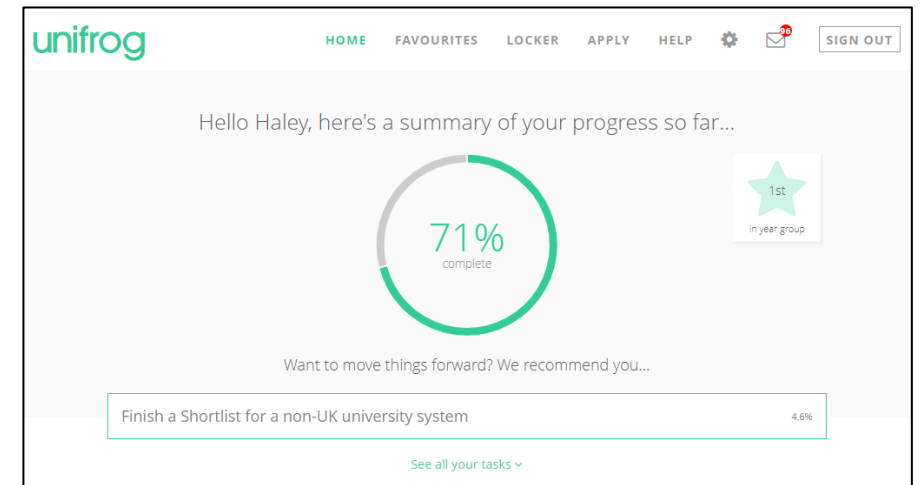
